“Blue Luna”



Inspired by the moon and last name of the founder, this pendant has been carved with the phases of the moon and the dark night is suspended on a delicate chain. Finished in a matte patina this piece creates space for contemplation, intuitive thought, and connection to our inner cycles.



“ZICATELA”



Inspired by the sun-soaked shores of Puerto Escondido, the Zicatela Necklace embodies effortless coastal elegance. Its organic textures and fluid design echo the rhythm of the ocean and the warmth of Zicatela Beach. A timeless piece that brings the essence of the sea to every moment.



“Rooted Light”



Made from twisted recycled silver this piece has an organic style inspired by the roots of a tree growing towards the light. With tactile textures, tactile qualities, and organic forms, this piece celebrates the beauty of imperfection for those who walk bright but grounded.

In every Lumina piece, there is stillness and movement, memory and possibility. Worn close to the body, they become personal talismans reminders to stay grounded, aware, and connected to something greater.

“Tide”

Wired by the waves, tides of the ocean, and their colors, this pendant drapes gracefully across your collarbone. Made from 100% recycled and collected materials, and finished in a soft satin finish, this is a daily reminder to move with grace and fluidity, just like the sea.

Crafted in gold-plated brass with hand-applied enamel, the Rooted Light Necklace features a sculpted triangular pendant inspired by the meeting of sunlight and earth. Its polished finish and organic pattern highlight the balance between natural texture and refined design.

Designed with natural stone and hand-polished crystal, the Tide Necklace captures the fluid essence of the sea. Set in sterling silver with a brushed finish, each piece reflects light like ocean waves in motion.

Made of gold-plated brass with a hand-cut natural leather inlay, the Zicatela Necklace combines bold geometry with organic texture. The contrast between the soft patterned surface and the metallic frame evokes the balance of sun and shadow along Puerto Escondido's coast.
